CREDIT COURSES AND PROVINCIAL EXAMINATIONS

JULY 27th - 31st

Provincial examinations will take place between July 27 , and August 31, 2020, inclusive. A maximum of two courses may be taken. Courses commence July 6, (see calendar on reverse side) and they terminate on the day of examination. Students must attend all classes.

Classes are small, and students receive individual attention. As a result, the school's record of success has been high.
